# Individual Learning Accounts (ILAs)

ILAs are administered entirely by *learnirect scotland*, not the College. They are two different organisations.

We regret that College staff are **not** able to advise applicants for College courses about ILAs. For example, staff cannot inform or advise applicants or the members of public on the eligibility of College courses for ILAs or inform or advise applicants or the members of public on their eligibility to apply for, obtain, or use ILAs. These are matters exclusively for *learnirect scotland*.

If you are interested in an ILA or what you can use it for, in general or specifically, please refer directly to *learnirect scotland* for advice.

We hope the College will be able to offer you the course of your choice, but it is for you to ensure that you can make payment of the appropriate course fee. It is also your responsibility to provide the evidence required by the College that you are eligible to pay a reduced fee, or obtain the course for free. Evidence of eligibility to pay a reduced (or no) fee, or use an ILA as part-payment, needs to be given to the College at the time of **booking/payment**.

When you accept the offer of a course, you have entered into a contract with the College, and it is your responsibility to settle the fee for the course by means acceptable to the College.

The College's decision on whether or not an ILA can be used for payment purposes is final. **Please note that an ILA will not be accepted as payment for a course after you have entered into a contract with the College.**
