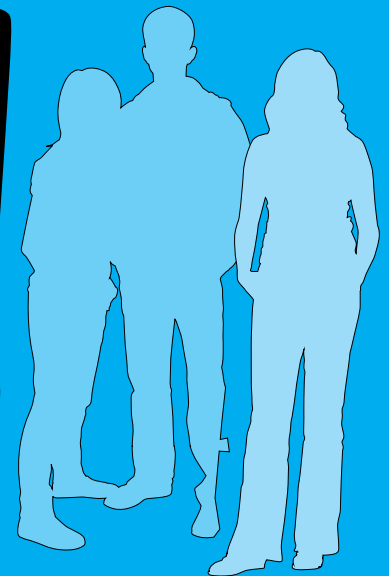

Information for Pupils and Parents

Your school has joined with Aberdeen College to offer you the opportunity to undertake a vocational qualification as part of your school studies. This information leaflet is designed to answer your questions and explain a bit about the course you will be taking.

What is it?

The Art and Design Intermediate 2 course has been designed to provide a certificated course incorporating a variety of Art and Design skills. School pupils will benefit from experiencing a range of different Art media which are available for study at an Advanced level. Pupils involved in this course will be introduced to the range of future study options and vocations in these subject areas.

What will I learn?

During the course you will:

- Learn how to experiment with techniques in Art and Design and benefit from demonstrations by professionals.
- Develop an awareness of health and safety in the Art and Design Studio
- Develop skills which can enhance your performance in your Art and Design Higher course

How will I be taught?

You will be taught by means of practical and theoretical based activities within the Art and Design Department at Aberdeen College. You will spend half a school day each week at the Gallowgate Centre of Aberdeen College.

What will I study?

Work on Different projects such as:

- Fashion and Textiles
- Sculpture and 3D Design
- Experimental Drawing and Mixed Media skills
- Visual Communication and Photography.

What do I need?

Whilst you are taking part in the course you will be required to always:
